SERVICES

1. St. John Library operates by following the practices similar to any public libraries to the extent possible. Books and membership enrolment are entered into and managed on our computer system.
2. All parishioners, including RCIA catechumens, can apply in person, during our operating hours, for a library card. Each library card holder is entitled to borrowing privileges of up to four (4) books and multi media items included, for a period of 2 weeks. 3. We also sell religious items and selected books which are sold strictly on a cost recovery, no return and no exchange basis. No sale taxes are collected and no receipts are issued.
4. Occasionally we have free books and religious items for parishioners to take home as needed. Parishioners are free to make a donation if they so wish.
