

May 24 (Sat): Jubilee Walking Pilgrimage to St Barnabas Parish

11:00am: Rosary

11:30am: Memorial Mass of Our Lady Help of Christians: Pray for the Church in China

Please note:

- Since the purpose of the Jubilee Walking Pilgrimage is to repent and mortify one's sins, personal necessities (such as water...) will not be provided and one must bring one's own.
- Wearing the parish green T-shirts or ministry clothing is encouraged during pilgrimage.
- The full distance walk takes two hours and is only suitable for healthy adults who can take care of themselves. Children or those not in excellent health can choose to take the half-distance walk, school bus or drive themselves - school buses do not have seat belts and children under four years old are not allowed.
- Please check your condition that day. If you do not feel excellent, please take the school bus or rest at home.
- Please pay attention to the weather forecast. If the weather is very bad or there is a thunderstorm warning, please check the parish announcement. The walk may be cancelled, but you can still take the school bus.
- Always obey traffic rules when walking, especially when crossing roads and train tracks.
- Volunteers are limited, so we ask parishioners to practice the virtue of Charity and support each other. Those who belong to the same ministry are encouraged to walk together. If there is any problem, please help by notifying the volunteers.
- If you need to leave the group for any reason during the walk, please go to St. Barnabas Parish on your own.
- There are few washrooms in St Barnabas Parish. We recommend you use the facilities at CMCC or Malvern Town Centre.

Full Distance Walk

- Please arrive before 8:05 that day and register with volunteers, and you will be given a sticker to wear for identification when walking
- 8:25am: Father Lu will start the prayer and give blessings
- 8:30am: Start walking for about two hours (10:30am)

Half Distance Walk

- Ride the school bus as you would a TTC bus
- CMCC - Meeting time: 9:30am
- 9:45am - The school bus should have arrived. Get on the bus. Show your ticket to the bus leader but keep your ticket. The bus will leave once it is full.
- Please note that all school buses must leave CMCC by 10:00 am. Do not be late.
- Arrive around 10:45am

After Mass


Get on the bus, show your ticket to the bus leader and the bus will leave when it is full. The last bus will leave at 12:50pm

Parking

CMCC: We have obtained a permit from the government to park at the location indicated on the notice board outside the parish office, but everyone still needs to obey all traffic regulations (regarding parking and crossing the road)


Prayer Intentions
